Bursary information

Purpose

The purpose is to assist brethren, children, grandchildren, wives and widows of brethren and deceased brethren in the jurisdiction (Province) of New Brunswick with university/college/trade school education.

Basis of awards

The financial circumstances of the applicant/family will be the foremost consideration in awarding bursaries.

Requirements

The bursaries are available to attend any university/college/trade school and at any level of study.

Payment of bursaries

The amount of the bursary shall be paid directly to the university/college/trade school which the student is attending. Should one or more bursaries fail to be awarded during the year, the amount of such bursary shall be used for additional bursaries in future years.

Selection of the applicants

Application for these bursaries shall be made in writing on GLNB2024 masonic bursary only. All other forms are not acceptable. Very important! Applications not fully completed will not be considered.

Applications must be fully completed and signed by the Applicant, Responsible adult- if applicant is a dependant, Worshipful Master, and Secretary of the Mason's lodge.

Make sure the application is fully completed, attach the following three items:

- 1. This completed form,
- 2. Proof of acceptance from the College/University/Trade School, and
- 3. Colour photograph suitable for publication/social media (passport type of photo 2½" x 3½").
